Guidance for referees

You have been named as one of two referees in support of an applicant to the <u>PhB (Honours)</u> - <u>Science</u> degree at The Australian National University.

The PhB (Honours) - Science degree is a highly selective research based undergraduate degree designed to extend the abilities of high-achieving students.

To assist in the selection of students, please provide a report setting out your views on the applicant's suitability for the PhB (Honours) - Science program.

Your report should include:

- 1. the applicant's full name.
- 2. the applicant's ANU applicant number.
- 3. details of the degree to which the applicant is applying (e.g. PhB Science).
- 4. your name, email address and telephone number.

Your report should address the following points:

- In which year/s of the applicant's student career have you known him/her and in what capacity/ies (e.g. class teacher, careers adviser, principal).
- How you would anticipate this applicant would perform if challenged with material of greater intellectual depth than normally given in an undergraduate degree.
- Your opinion of the applicant's research ability or promise.
- How you would rank this applicant with his/her peers in the years you have been associated with students at this level.
